3 - B

BEDFORD BOYS BASEBALL (3-B) was

founded and organized by Mr. Bud (Arnold) Sherer in 1957 as an activity to fill the summers of area boys. On Sunday afternoons in the summer of 1957 area boys would meet at the ball field in Samaria under the supervision of Mr. Scherer and other fathers to play and learn the fundamentals of baseball.

The first game of the 3-B league was played in 1958. The league's five teams (90 boys) played their senior division games in Toledo and their minor and junior division games in Trilby. The league membership was headed by a Board of Commissioners, appointed by Mr. Scherer which included Dr. Thomas J. Keane, Martin Hammerstein, Norman Crary, Harlan Van Diehlen, Leo Bofia, William Winson, Thomas Pruden, Barton Cook, Walter Bielski, Dr. Daniel Soda and Arthur Maschke.



The Commissioners, coaches and players have seen their children -- and often grandchildren -- participate in 3-B over the years, and have seen membership grow to as high as 600. Parents and business leaders have contributed money, equipment and time over the years. A mothers auxiliary to 3-B was formed in 1960, lasting nearly a decade and offered a variety of social functions to area women.

One outstanding feature of 3-B is that no area teams are in existence. Boys from all areas of the township are on all teams. Mr. Scherer insisted on this by his original bylaws, in order to promote better community respect, spirit, and cooperation.

A testimony to Mr. Scherer's foresight is that the original constitution and by-laws which he personally prepared are still unchanged after 36 years.

GLOSSARY

Balk An illegal and deceptive move made by the pitcher. It is a change in the pitcher's normal delivery designed to deceive a base runner. Penalty: each runner advances one base.

Batter's box The rectangular areas to the left and right of home plate where batters must stand while batting.

Blooper A short fly ball to the outfield.

Bunt A soft hit resulting from the batter simply holding the bat out and letting the ball hit it rather than from swinging the bat.

Changeup A pitch thrown at a slower-than-normal speed, in an effort the throw off the batter's swing.

Cutoff A ball, generally thrown by an outfielder, that is intercepted by an infielder, who then relays the ball to the plate or another base.

Earned run A run scored without any errors, passed balls, obstructions or other interferences.

Error A fielding misplay or wild throw that allows the batter to reach base, or a runner to advance a base.

Force-out A play in which a fielder who has the ball retires a runner by tagging the base the runner is proceeding to before the runner arrives there, Force-outs apply only with a runner on first, runners on first and second, runners on first, second and third, or runners on first and third (in this situation, only the man on first can be forced).

Full count When there are three balls and two strikes on the batter. *Gland slam* A home run hit with the bases loaded.

Line drive A hard-hit ball that travels parallel to the ground, rather than in a rainbow-like path.

Passed ball A pitch that gets past the catcher, and that the catcher should have caught or blocked.

Pickoff A sudden throw by the pitcher or the catcher to an infielder in an effort to catch a runner off base.

Pitchout A ball deliberately pitched wide of the strike zone so the batter can't reach it. Pitchouts are generally used so the catcher has a better chance to catch a runner who is trying to steal a base.

Run batted in (RBI) A statistic that credits a batter for driving in a run with a hit, a sacrifice, a base on balls or by being hit with a pitch.

Rundown A play in which a runner is caught between two fielders and tagged out.

Sacrifice A bunt that advances a base runner at the expense of the batter who is thrown out at first base.

Sacrifice fly A fly to the outfield that scores a base runner after the ball is caught.

Tagging up Returning to a base until a fly ball is caught, and then running to the next base.

There will be over 700 boys playing baseball in 1993 in forty three in-house teams and seven travel teams. Some of you may be unaware that our program doesn't stop at the 14 year old Colt division. We have two 15 & 16 year old non-school teams that play in the city of Toledo, and two 15 & 16 year old school teams that play in the SAAB. We also have one 17 & 18 year old school team that plays in the Suburban League.

There are several people who contribute countless hours to 3B. For these fantastic volunteers the baseball season has no beginning and no end; it is 12 months per year. I am extremely grateful to work with these wonderful people. Don Sloan, Don Duckworth, Bill Zgorzelski, Tom Flynn, Donna Decker, Denny Hankins, Cindy Andrews, and Cheryl Liggett comprise the main body of 3B administration. We have a board of Commissioners which oversees the entire operation and countless numbers of volunteers who do varied tasks throughout the operation of the League.
