

Al Prieur named deputy supervisor in Bedford

BEDFORD TOWNSHIP — Al Prieur of Temperance has been chosen as the deputy supervisor for Bedford Township, and is scheduled to be sworn in at the next Bedford Township Board meeting Tuesday.

His experience includes marketing, business development and strategic planning.

Supervisor Paul Pirrone said there were 27 applications. Two panels of four people each looked over the packets; then after phone interviews took place the candidates were narrowed to five finalists.

All five of them were good choices, Mr. Pirrone said, but Mr. Prieur stood out among that group.

“It was unanimous to pick Al,” he said.

After his election in November, Mr. Pirrone had asked for a deputy supervisor in lieu of an administrative assistant. Because the assistant job was eliminated, Kim Pollins, who had worked with the previous supervisor Greg Stewart, is no longer a township employee.
